## MICKEY SUNSHINE BOWL



## **MATERIALS**

- Stackable Bowl (SKU DB31510)
  - Tape
  - Small round brush
  - Medium round brush
    - Mickey template
      - Tracing paper
        - Paint:
        - 46,35,69

- **TIPS**
- Mix water and paint before adding dish soap.
- Allow bubbles to pop on their own.
- Let the paint dry completely between coats.
- This technique can be applied to most bowls.



## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- **1.** Wipe bowl clean with damp sponge.
- 2. Tape from the bottom of the rim to the top of the rim in a slant to the right then tape again and slant to the left to create a triangle. Repeat until you've the covered the rim. You should have a sun in the middle of your bowl.
- **3.** Paint the sun using a medium round brush and #46. (3 coats, allow paint to dry between coats.)
- **4.** Carfully peel away the tape.
- **5.** Paint the rest of the bowl with #35 and a medium round brush. Use a small round brush to paint between the sun triangles. (3 coats, allow paint to dry between coats.)
- **6.** Tape the Mickey Template over tracing paper and trace onto the inside of the bowl. (If the tracing is difficult to see, gently go over it with a pencil.)
- 7. With a medium round brush paint Mickey with #69. (3 coats, allow paint to dry between coats.)
- **8.** Make bubble mix with 4 tablespoons of water, 2 tablespoons of paint (#85), and a drop of dish soap. Mix well. Using a straw blow gently into the mix to create bubbles.
- **9.** Flip bowl upside down and carefully place bubbles to the outside of the bowl. Allow the bubbles to pop on their own and dry before turning your bowl over.
